Starting a New Meeting

Please follow these important guidelines for a new meeting to be posted on the Houston SLAA website:

1. Contact the chair of Intergroup to be put on the agenda at the monthly Intergroup meeting (1st Saturday of each month) to present details and plans for the new meeting.
2. Register the meeting with Fellowship Wide Services.
3. Experience tells us that before starting a new meeting, it is important to get a group of five or six people to commit to attending the meeting for the beginning months. That will ensure a regular attendance. We also ask the person starting the new meeting attend every meeting for at least the first six months.
4. When the meeting has received a number from Fellowship Wide Services, the number can be given to the literature chair, and the new meeting will be entitled to a starter kit of literature which consists of one basic texts and several pamphlets.
