### **Additional requirements for attendance at the SLAA Men's Retreat:**

The SLAA retreat is open to participants with at least 90 days active in SLAA recovery prior to the date of the retreat.

Attendees with less than 180 days in the SLAA program should have a sponsor at the retreat. Anyone with less than 180 days in the SLAA program who does not have a sponsor at the retreat, must notify a member of the Retreat Leadership Team to get a temporary sponsor assigned to them.

During the retreat, it is important for participants to be sober from illegal substances and alcohol.

***These requirements are in the spirit of SLAA Tradition 5:  
Each group has but one primary purpose — to carry its message to the sex and love addict who still suffers.***

### **Onsite Atmosphere:**

This is a spiritual, healing-oriented retreat; it is not a workshop. To protect the sanctity of the retreat and the experience of others, participants are required to stay onsite and avoid outside distractions from the start of the retreat until the end. Your presence and active participation are important to your own and others' recovery and spiritual growth.

In the event of a personal emergency or other unavoidable, extenuating circumstances, the participant is requested to discuss the matter with a Retreat Co-Chair, Retreat Facilitator, and/or with a member of the Holy Name Retreat Center staff.

### **Registration Details:**

The \$265 fee includes meals and private lodging. Online registration is available until the retreat begins. Once all spots are filled, a waiting list will be maintained.

The online registration process includes a provision to donate additional funds to support the retreat. Please consider donating to support attendance by others who may not otherwise be able to attend.

Refund requests received before 1:00 p.m. on Friday the WEEK PRIOR to the retreat will be honored. A \$50.00 processing fee will be deducted from the refund amount.

*For the sake of anonymity, non-registered guests are not allowed onsite. Check-in and fellowship will begin Friday at 4:00 p.m. Dinner will be served at 6:00 p.m. Smoking is only allowed outside in designated areas. Departure time is Sunday at 12:30 p.m.*
